AS reiterated that Lancs had put forward a plan in the past for a similar project. A proposal is to be put together to place with Steve Grainger to see if we can gain this funding.

## Disciplinary.

BHS provided a summary report of the season to date. (Appendix 1)

- 1. BHS Highlighted concern over recent sending off, the nature of the offences and the number of Colts and Junior offenders.
- 2. HHH proposed publicising the outcomes of the disciplinary cases more widely on social media.
- 3. It was noted that referee abuse was worse on a Sunday at Junior matches and was deterring people from refereeing. PD suggested a reason for the abuse, whilst no excuse, could be the standard of refereeing being low due to them being either coaches or parents. Would there be a way we could help them get qualifications.
- 4. MD suggested inviting the M & J Chairs from clubs to the cluster meetings to explain the consequences of their player and spectator behaviour and how it could effect Senior XV league points.
- 5. As decision was to run a social media campaign about respecting referees and match officials.
