## CB Relationship Managers Report.

## D. Westhead reported:

- 1. Adult Male Recovery Project Phoenix going well, help is being given to Bolton, Littleborough, Wigan and Liverpool Collegiate to increase numbers of lower teams from their colts sides. Broughton seem to be on a recovery path with players training and 2 fixtures arranged.
- 2. Delta Williams is on maternity leave and is being covered by Katie Crute for coach development.
- 3. Womens & Girls RFU are concerned with the number of girls playing nationally. Clubs are to be targeted who have expressed a wish to grow the girls game, applied for U12s funding or applied (or run) an Inner Warrior event.
- 4. Starting to conduct a piece of work around Adult Registration which is effective as of 1<sup>st</sup> July. First action is to get their existing player data in order, email addresses etc. There is a club webinar scheduled for 29<sup>th</sup> February.
- 5. 10 Lancashire clubs successful in applying for the Funded Volunteer Initiative.
- 6. Honda Volunteer of the Year GAB confirmed 26 Nominations across 19 clubs so far.
- 7. DC- We need to re-look at clubs with 1<sup>st</sup> XVs in the NOWIRUL Leagues and promote a return to RFU leagues.
- 8. 1<sup>st</sup> aid vouchers MD reported that 48 vouchers had been distributed from the 111 available after the recent push.
- 9. Bystander Training MD reported on the concerns of MJW about the training at West Park and the lack of feedback from the RFU. MD to contact Rowan Whittle who is the West Park liaison and discuss the way forward.
