LANCASHIRE ROYALS NEWS

Last season Lancashire launched an exciting new Representative side to showcase the talents of players playing at Level 5 and below in the RFU League structure. Nearly 40 players from 17 Clubs took part in two games against the iconic Anti-Assassins Club and the full Cumbria County XV. This year following Lancashire's lead, neighbours Cheshire are also launching a similar side. Currently the game between Lancashire Royals & the yet to be officially named Cheshire XV will take place on Wednesday 15th November with the venue to be confirmed.

Lancashire Royals are now seeking nominations from Clubs of their players to trial on Wednesday 18th October at Wigan RUFC 7.45pm.

All Lancashire County RFU Clubs from Level 5 (North Premier) down to Level 9 can nominate up to FIVE players to trial of which a total of 3 will be included in any match day squad.

It is hoped the Anti-Assassins fixture will become an annual fixture with this year's pencilled in for Saturday 30th December, at a venue to be confirmed.
